The school boundary zone for Lansdowne Elementary consists of a part of 5 neighborhood profile areas (see map on reverse). A slightly lower percent of residents in Lansdowne feeder neighborhoods own homes compared to the county average, and a smaller percentage of residents receive food assistance. All feeder neighborhoods have a lower incidence of juvenile arrest and a lower percentage of births to adolescents compared to the county average. A smaller percentage of adults are struggling with un- or under-employment.

The chart to the right illustrates the demographics of the students served at Lansdowne Elementary. There is a lower percentage of economically disadvantaged students compared to the district as a whole, and an equivalent student mobility rate. This indicates a relatively smaller risk for low academic achievement.

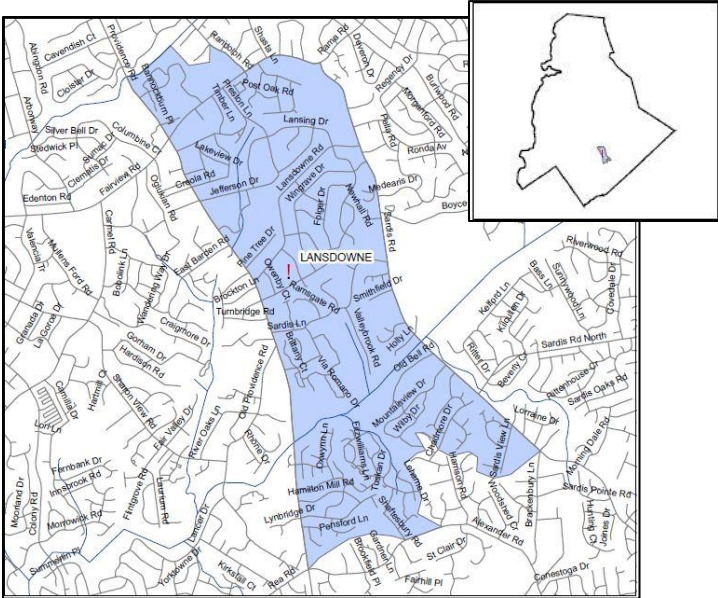

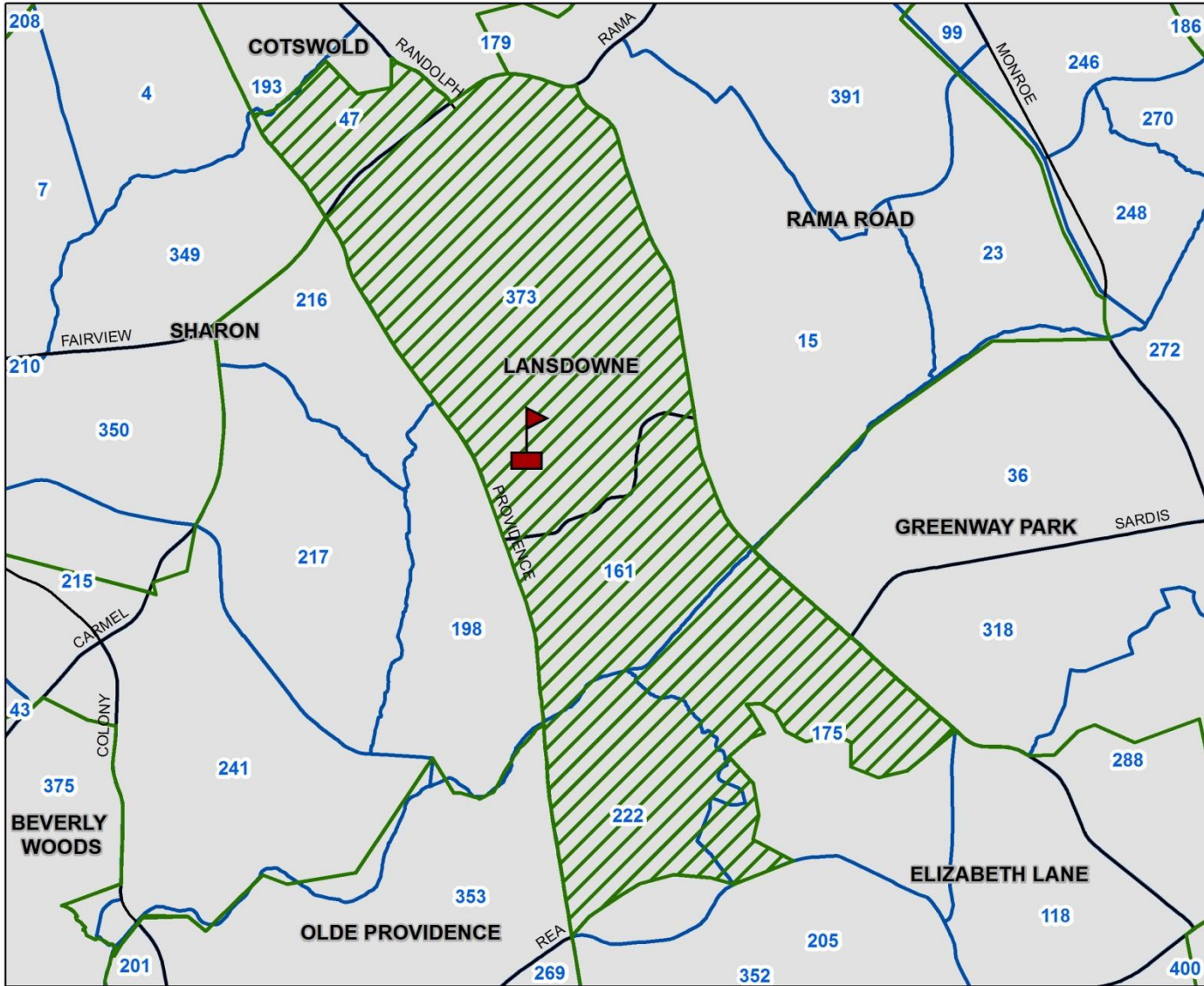
Lansdowne Elementary feeder neighborhoods have a generally higher percentage of students on grade level than the county average. Only one neighborhood has a dropout rate higher than the county average and only one neighborhood has a higher percentage of students with 10 or more unexcused absences. This also indicates a relatively smaller risk for low academic achievement.
